1. Data processors

2. Purposes and means of data processing

5. Data retention period

6. Your rights

We inform you that you, as the data subject, enjoy the rights referred to in sections 2, 3 and 4 of Chapter III of Regulation (EU) 2016/679.

You are entitled, as the data subject, to the rights provided for by the following articles: art. 15 "Right of access by the data subject"; art. 16 "Right to rectification"; art. 17 "Right to erasure"; art. 18 "Right to restriction of processing"; art. 20 "Right to data portability" of EU Regulation 2016/679 within the limits and under the conditions set out in art. 12 of the Regulation itself.
